## \$167,000 TO AID KANSAS EDUCATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced five Health, Education and Welfare grants, totalling \$167,000, to four Kansas Colleges and to the State Department of Education.

The Kansas State Department of Education will receive \$57,000 for the Kansas Coordinated Program to Train Education Teachers to Work with the Handicapped. The funds will be used to improve the quality and increase the supply of educational personnel trained to work with handicapped children.

Kansas State College of Pittsburg, Hesston College, Donnelly College and Baker University will all receive grants for the planning, establishment, expansion or carrying out of Cooperative Education Programs. Cooperative Education programs are those which alternate periods of full-time academic study with periods of full-time public or private employment. Donnelly College and Baker University will each receive \$30,000 from HEW and Hesston College and Kansas State College of Pittsburg will receive \$25,000 each.
