ADDITIONAL FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE FOR BRIDGEPORT PROJECT

WASHINGTON, D.C. --Senator Bob Dole and Congressman Garner Shriver today announced that an additional \$2 million dollars will be made available by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Wichita Urban Renewal Agency for the Bridgeport Project. Dole and Shriver had previously announced \$3 million in funding and today's announcement brings the total to \$5 million.

Dole and Shriver have both been working closely with HUD officials over the past several months in an effort to obtain adequate funding for the project.
