WASHINGTON, D.C.—Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today six grants from the Office of Economic Opportunity totalling \$107,400 to agencies in Kansas.

All the grants will be used to counteract conditions of malnutrition through food and nutrition programs, with the overall thrust directed toward increasing participation of low-income residents in food programs.

Following are the grants announced today:

- \$12,000 -- East Central Kansas Economic Opportunity Corporation, Ottawa
serves Coffey, Douglas, Franklin, Osage, Miami and Lyon counties
- \$21,000 -- Kansas Council of Agricultural Workers and Low-Income Families, Inc., Garden City
serves Finney, Greeley, Grant, Kearney, Scott, Sherman, Stanton, Wallace,
Wichita and Haskell counties
- \$15,000 -- Shawnee County Community Assistance and Action, Inc.
serves Shawnee county
- \$20,400 -- NEK-CAP, Inc., Horton
serves Brown, Atchison, Doniphan, Jackson and Nemaha counties
- \$15,000 -- Senion Service, Inc., Wichita
serves City of Wichita
- \$24,000 -- SEK-CAP, Inc., Girard
serves Allen, Bourbon, Linn, Crawford, Cherokee, Labette and Montgomery counties.
