\$50,000 IN GRANTS TO KANSAS LATINOS, MMIGRANTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced nearly \$50,000 in grants for manpower projects to benefit Spanish-speaking and migrant workers in Kansas.

Contracts were signed with Jobs for Progress, Inc., to further SER programs which provide manpower services through basic education, language, vocational training and placement assistance. SER programs in Kansas City and Wichita received \$13,850 and \$24,756, respectively.

A \$10,000 grant went to the Kansas Council of Agricultural Workers and Low Income Families, Inc.,intGarden City, to be used to meet the basic needs of migrant workers seeking permanent jobs.
