\$254,000 LOAN FOR POTTAWATOMIE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #1

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced today that the Farmers Home

Administration has approved an additional loan of \$254,000 under the Rural Development

Program to the Rural Water District No. 1 of Pottawatomie county to help finance
the completion of its water system to serve residnets with good quality water for
domestice use as well as agricultural purposes. FHA previously loaned \$911,000
to construct this system and extend services to additional customers in the county.

This water district is located in the south portion of Pottawatomie and the system consists of 120 miles of water lines, 2 standpipes and two wells. Some 406 water users will be connected to the system. The loan will be repaid in 40 years at an interest rate of 5 percent.

Chairman of Rural Water District No. 1 (Pottawatomie county) is John L. Hableutzel, Wamego.
