WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that as much as \$128,000 will be made available to Kansas in Fiscal Year 1975 to assist the State in developing and carrying out a State energy program.

Dole said Federal Energy Administrator John Sawhill had informed him guidelines are now being developed for use of the money and states will soon be able submit an application outlining planned resource development and conservation activities. Kansas is eligible to receive a maximum of \$128,000 under Public Law 93-322, which assists states in carrying out energy programs.
