MC PHERSON COUNTY RECIEVES DISASTER DESIGNATION

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that the Farmers Home Administration will today designate McPherson County eligible for their emergency loan program because of damages and losses caused by the severe storm May 13, 1974.

"Farmers who suffered damages in that storm should contact the local Farmers Home Administration office," Dole said, "to see if they qualify for the 5 percent loans. They have until November 25, 1974 to apply for physical losses and June 26, 1975 for production losses."

Dole added that while this seems like a long time since the disasterous storm struck, designation terminates the period of time in which losses can be calculated. There will be no need for applicants to show they are unable to obtain credit elsewhere.
