NEARLY \$2.5 MILLION FOR MANHATTAN EPA PROJECT

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$2,490,000 Environmental Protection Agency grant to Manhattan. The money will be used for construction of a complete mix activated sludge treatment facility, lift station interceptor, sewer from existing lift station to new plant, storm water settling basins, sludge holding lagoons and sludge disposal system.

Manhattan had previously received \$4,110,000 for the project and today's announcement brings the total to \$6,600,000.
