## DOLE TELEGRAM TO DALE LYONS

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- Following is the text of a telegram sent by Senator Bob Dole Tuesday morning to Dale Lyons, President of the Kansas Farmers Union :

HEARD OF YOUR BLAST CONCERNING THE KANSAS CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION. THOUGH YOU ARE TOTALLY PARTISAN, YOU WOULD DO YOUR MEMBERS A SERVICE BY CHECKING WITH THE DEMOCRATIC HOPEFULS FOR PRESIDENT. YOU WILL FIND THAT MOST OF THEM ARE DIRECTED AND CONTROLLED BY LABOR LEADERS, PARTICULARLY GOERGE MEANY. DON'T FORGET, IT WAS MR. MEANY WHO DIRECTED THE INTERNATIONAL LONGSHOREMAN'S ASSOCIATION TO HALT THE LOADING OF GRAIN TO THE SOVIET UNION AND, IN EFFECT, BROUGHT ABOUT THE EMBARGO.

WHERE WERE YOU THEN MR. LYONS?? YOUR UNUSUAL SILENCE WAS NOTED.
