\$632,000 REA LOAN TO KAW VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$632,000 Rural Electrification Administration loan from the Department of Agriculture to the Kaw Valley Electric Cooperative Company, Inc. of Topeka. The cooperative serves Shawnee, Jackson, Pottawatomie, Wabaunsee, Douglas and Osage Counties.

The funds will be used to finance service for 244 additional consumers, 28 miles of distribution line, four miles of transmission line, additional headquarters facilities and system improvements.

President of the cooperative is Mr. Darryl Little of Silver Lake and the manager is Fred R. Stone of Topeka.
