Dole was also informed of a promising new biological control that should be available in the coming year. This biological agent, Nosema locustae, is now under development and appears to be both highly effective and inexpensive.

Jellinek told Dole:

"EPA will commit both funding and our laboratory resources to aid in the development of health and safety data on Nosema locustae to facilitate the registration of the biological agent for use next year."
