MOVING THE OLYMPICS: A MODEST PROPOSAL

"Senator Baker has come up with an interesting approach to the problem of the Olympics, in suggesting that they be moved to Puerto Rico. Perhaps he should have given the matter more thought. That way, we could put the Olympics into a number of early primary states.
