DOLE ANNOUNCES NEW STATEWIDE TOLL-FREE FIC SERVICE

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) today announced the establishment of a new, statewide toll-free Federal Information Center (FIC) service now offered by the recently inaugurated Topeka FIC.

All residents of Kansas can now call the Topeka FIC on either a local or toll-free '800' number. These centers were designed to assist people who have questions about Federal services, programs, and regulations, but do not know where to turn for an answer.
