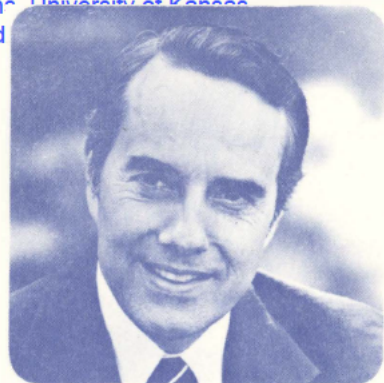

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole (R-Kan.), along with Senator Roger Jepsen (R-Iowa), Rep. Tom Hagedorn (R-Minn.) and other Republican congressmen, will hold a press conference Thursday, July 3, 1980, on the Soviet grain embargo.

The conference will be at 10 a.m. in front of the main (north) entrance to the north USDA Building. This is the side that bounds the Mall on Jefferson Drive.

Dole announced that the participants will spell out their opposition to the Administration's policy.

Dole also said that tomorrow at 10 a.m. Pacific Time, Governor Ronald Reagan will also spell out his position on the embargo through a statement being issued by key advisors in Los Angeles. Dole has been working closely with Reagan on agriculture-related issues. Not only does Dole serve on the Senate Agriculture Committee, but he is chairman of the Republican Platform Committee's agriculture subcommittee.
