DOLE ACCEPTS JOINT INVITATIONS

(Topeka, Kansas) -- Senator Bob Dole announced today that he has accepted invitations to make joint appearances with his Democratic opponent in four Kansas cities during October.

The invitations are as follows:

October 12	Johnson County League of Women Voters
October 13	Pittsburg Chamber of Commerce
October 14	League of Kansas Municipalities (Wichita)
October 18	Great Bend Javcees

In addition, Senator Dole said he is interested in scheduling a joint appearance in Topeka during October.

"I look forward to these joint appearances and believe there should be one such forum in all five Congressional Districts. Recent developments in the conflict between Iran and Iraq may make it necessary for the Senate to remain in session beyond the scheduled recess date so that the full implications for the United States can be fully assessed," Dole said.

"I believe that the people of Kansas expect me to stay on the job, fulfilling my elected responsibilities. I have been coming home each weekend and recess period for the past several months, and look forward to campaigning daily in every section of the state when the Senate finally recesses," Dole said.

Senator Dole will be visiting Wichita, Marion, Overland Park, and Bonner Springs this weekend.
