DOLE, BYRD REACH AGREEMENT TO BRING UP SUPERFUND BILL IN NOVEMBER

WASHINGTON-- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) and Majority Leader Robert Byrd (D.-W.V.) reached an agreement last night that will allow the so-called "Superfund" bill to come before the Senate by November 21st.

Dole and other members of the Senate met with Byrd in the final hours before recess late last night to work out an agreement which would have two Senate Committees-- Finance; Environment and Public Works-- consider the bill.

"I have been on record for some time as favoring this legislation," Senator Dole said Thursday. "There have been some jurisdictional problems that we've needed to overcome, and I'm pleased to report that such an agreement has been worked out," Dole said.

Met With EPA Head

Senator Dole met yesterday with Environmental Protection Agency head Douglas Costle in Washington and, among other things, they discussed the Superfund legislation.

The Senate will return November 12, following the national elections.
