DOLE RECIPIENT OF "GOOD LAWS FOR SOUND CREDIT" AWARD

WASHINGTON - Senator Robert Dole (R.-Kan.) today was a recipient of the "Good Laws for Sound Credit" award, given by the National Association of Credit Management (NACM). The Association, one of America's largest and oldest business organizations, similarly honored Senator Jake Garn (R. Utah) and Representative M. Caldwell Butler (R. Virginia).

NACM is composed of business executives from about 45,000 manufacturers, wholesalers, service industries and financial institutions. Most of the member companies are small businesses, including most of Kansas' 250 business members. However, 95% of the Fortune 500 firms also belong to the Association.

The organization cited Senator Dole for his leadership and accomplishments as Chairman of the Judiciary Subcommittee on the Courts, particularly in recent legislation that reformed federal bankruptcy law.
