ELIZABETH DOLE, MORRIS KAY AGREE: THIRD YEAR TAX CUT IS GOOD FOR KANSAS

TOPEKA -- Presidential Assistant Elizabeth Dole, in a campaign visit to Topeka today for Congressional candidate Morris Kay, questioned Kay's opponent, who is advocating an additional half billion dollar tax burden on Kansas taxpayers over the next two years.
