DOLE AND KASSEBAUM ANNOUNCE FEDERAL FUNDS TO KANSAS
FOR PREVENTION OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum today announced that the U.S. Department of Justice has awarded the State of Kansas \$421,000 to fund juvenile justice and delinquency prevention programs through September 30, 1986.

The grant money will be used to support programs to develop, maintain, and expand juvenile delinquency prevention services; divert juveniles from the juvenile justice system; provide community-based alternatives to confinement in secure detention and correctional facilities; and improve programs for serious juvenile offenders.

The funds will be awarded to the State's Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services.

Dear Senator:

Under the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended, funds are awarded by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention to the states, based upon a formula reflecting each state's relative share of the nation's population aged 18 and under. These "formula" funds are then subgranted by the designated state agency to state and local government agencies and non-profit youth serving organizations.
