DOLE TO OUTLINE "DOWNPAYMENT" DEFICIT PACKAGE  
AT NATIONAL PRESS CLUB SPEECH ON WEDNESDAY

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole, Chairman of the Finance Committee, announced today that at a National Press Club speech next week he will outline the specifics of revenue options for a \$100 billion deficit reduction "downpayment" package.

Senator Dole will make his remarks on Wednesday, February 22, at a 1:00 p.m. speech, following a 12:30 p.m. luncheon at the National Press Building in Washington, D.C.

The options, as developed by the staffs of the Senate Finance Committee and the Joint Committee on Taxation, will be considered by the full Finance Committee the day after the Senator's National Press Club speech. The Committee's executive session is scheduled for 10:00 a.m., Thursday, February 23, 1984.
