DOLE TO ADDRESS AMERICAN SOCIETY OF NEWSPAPER EDITORS ON THURSDAY

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole will speak to the American Society of Newspaper Editors on Thursday morning, May 10. The 10:00 a.m. speech will be part of the Editors' annual convention at the Sheraton Washington Hotel.

In his address, Senator Dole will look ahead to the economic and legislative possibilities for 1985. The morning speech by Dole will precede a Thursday luncheon address to the group by former Vice President Walter Mondale.

Approximately 1,000 people from around the country will attend the three-day convention. Other speakers will include former President Richard Nixon, U.S. Secretary of State George Schultz, and Democrat presidential candidate Jesse Jackson.
