## DOLE STATEMENT ON ADMIRAL HYMAN G. RICKOVER

WASHINGTON -- SENATE MAJORITY LEADER BOB DOLE (R-KANS.) MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT ON THE DEATH OF ADMIRAL HYMAN G. RICKOVER.

"With the death of Admiral Rickover, we have has lost an authentic American hero and a true military pioneer. A Russian emigre, Admiral Rickover served this country unstintingly for sixty years — thirty of those years as head of the nation's nuclear army. Congress twice recognized the enormous contribution Admiral Rickover made to America's national security by awarding him the Congressional Gold Medal. No one deserved the honor more."
