ON THE NIGHT OF MONDAY, APRIL FOURTH, 1988, LAWRENCE, KANSAS BECAME AMERICA'S BASKETBALL CAPITAL.

ON THAT NIGHT -- IN KANSAS CITY -- THE JAYHAWKS CAPTURED THE NCAA BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP WITH A HEARTSTOPPING 83-TO-79 VICTORY OVER A VERY TALENTED OKLAHOMA SOONER SQUAD,

MR. PRESIDENT, TO HONOR THE TEAM'S GREAT ACHIEVEMENT, I AM TODAY INTRODUCING A RESOLUTION -- CO-SPONSORED BY MY DISTINGUISHED KANSAS COLLEAGUE, SENATOR NANCY KASSEBAUM -- THAT SALUTES THIS VERY SIGNIFICANT MOMENT IN KANSAS SPORTS HISTORY.
