

Dole Secures Passage of POW/MIA Flag Display; "We'll never forget our heroes" Republican Leader Vows

A flag commemorating American Prisoners of War and soldiers still Missing in Action will soon be displayed in the Rotunda of the U.S. Capitol, thanks to a bill by Kansas Senator Bob Dole.

Dole, a wounded and decorated combat veteran of WW II, is pictured above at the Capitol calling for passage of the legislation during National POW/MIA Recognition Day ceremonies.

Later that afternoon the House of Representatives okayed the Dole flag bill.

"The display of the flag in the Capitol sends a powerful signal around the world that the American people will never forget their captive and missing heroes," Dole said. "It will also be a tribute to the faith and courage of the families of our POW's and MIA's. We will never rest until we have a full accounting of America's fighting men and women."
