DOLE ANNOUNCES HUTCHINSON AIRPORT GRANT

Washington, D.C. -- SENATOR BOB DOLE (R-KS) ANNOUNCED TODAY A 90 PERCENT MATCHING GRANT FOR APRON OVERLAY AND REPLACEMENT OF AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR THE HUTCHINSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT. THE TOTAL FEDERAL SHARE OF THE SAFETY-RELATED PROJECT IS \$135,680.
