DOLE LAUDS ARRIVAL OF TRANS UNION DIVISION; WILL LOCATE IN WICHITA

Washington, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) today announced that the Trans Union Credit Information Company has selected Wichita as a future site for a credit bureau division.

"The WI/SE Partnership for Growth deserves credit for pursuing this important economic addition to its community," said Dole. "With an effort such as this Kansas' attractive business climate will no longer be the nation's best kept secret."

This division, the National Consumer Disclosure Division, will process all consumer inquiries for the credit bureaus affiliated with Trans Union. The new division will employ 125 people and is expected to open in 1990.

Trans Union, headquartered in Chicago, Illinois, is a national credit bureau with 1500 employees. The Marmon Group is composed of over 60 companies with combines revenues of \$3.2 billion.

In a letter to Mr. Allen Flitcraft, CEO of Trans Union Credit Information Company, Senator Dole promoted Wichita as an attractive site for the division.

"Wichita offers the most sophisticated telecommunications services available at lower costs than in most metropolitan areas," said Dole. "Qualified personnel resources are readily available at rates which are competitive with every section of the country."
