DOLE, HAYDEN ANNOUNCE MAJOR KANSAS TO TAIWAN CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT; HUTCHINSON, WICHITA, AND SABETHA INCLUDED IN \$36 MILLION PROJECT

Washington, D.C. -- SENATOR BOB DOLE (R-KS) AND GOVERNOR MIKE HAYDEN (R-KS) ANNOUNCED TODAY A \$36 MILLION CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD IN TAIWAN INVOLVING THREE KANSAS COMPANIES.
