DOLE WELCOMES "JAYHAWK" TRAINER TO KANSAS; BEECH WINS HISTORIC \$1 BILLION CONTRACT AS AIR FORCE MAKES "PERFECT 3-POINT LANDING IN WICHITA"

WASHINGTON -- KANSAS SENATOR BOB DOLE HAILED THE ANNOUNCEMENT TODAY THAT THE BEECH AIRCRAFT CORPORATION HAS WON THE COVETED \$1 BILLION AIR FORCE CONTRACT TO BUILD UP TO 211 NEW MILITARY JET TRAINERS. DOLE SAYS THE AIR FORCE WANTS TO CALL THE NEW AIRCRAFT THE "JAYHAWK". THE OVERALL ORDER REPRESENTS THE LARGEST IN BUSINESS JET HISTORY.

"THE WHEEL OF FORTUNE JUST STOPPED AT WICHITA. FOR THE AIR FORCE, IT'S A PERFECT 3-POINT LANDING -- GREAT PLANES, GREAT WORKERS AND A GREAT CITY, " DOLE SAID.

SENATORS DOLE AND KASSEBAUM HAVE BEEN THE LEADING PROPONENTS OF THE TRAINER AND DEFEATED CONTINUED EFFORTS IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO ZERO-OUT THE NEW TRAINER PROGRAM.

"THE 'JAYHAWK' WILL CONTINUE OUR STATE'S PROUD LEADERSHIP ON THE CUTTING EDGE OF AVIATION.
