DOLE RATED MOST EFFECTIVE REPUBLICAN IN CONGRESS

WASHINGTON - Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) has been rated the "most effective Republican in Congress" according to a recently released Business Week/Harris Poll.

304 Congressional aides were asked whom they considered the most effective leaders on Capitol Hill in interviews conducted between February 28th and March 9th, 1990.

When asked the question, ". . . about the top eleven top leaders in the Congress -- which of these do you think are the two or three most effective leaders?", Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole was the top Republican listed with a 42% rating. Only Speaker of the House Tom Foley and Senate Majority Leader George Mitchell topped Dole with a rating of 77% and 63% respectively. The poll has a +/- of less than 0.5%.
