DOLE ANNOUNCES \$1.6 MILLION AIRPORT GRANT FOR ULYSSES; FY91 FUNDS FOR RUNWAY CONSTRUCTION AND LIGHTING

WASHINGTON - SENATOR BOB DOLE (R-KS) TODAY ANNOUNCED THAT THE ULYSSES MUNICIPAL AIRPORT HAS BEEN AWARDED A \$1,614,240 GRANT FROM THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT'S AVIATION TRUST FUND.
