DOLE ANNOUNCES \$1 MILLION FOR OLATHE AND WICHITA AIRPORTS

WASHINGTON - Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) announced today that two Kansas airports will receive \$1,018,231 in FY90 discretionary funding from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Airport and Airways Trust Fund. The Colonel James Jabara Airport, Wichita, will receive \$180,000 and the Johnson County Executive Airport, Olathe, will receive \$838,231.

"I am pleased that Transportation Secretary Sam Skinner agrees with me that these worthy Kansas aviation projects will be funded through the Aviation Trust Fund. Air transportation is vital for community economic development in Kansas. As these and other Kansas airports continue to grow, I will work hard to ensure Kansas receives its fair share of these discretionary funds."

Funding for the Jabara Airport is to acquire land for approach protection. Similarly, money for Johnson County Executive Airport is to acquire land for approaches and fencing.
