CLAYTON, KS. WATER SYSTEM TO RECEIVE \$214,800

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today \$214,800 in grant and loan funding to Clayton, Kansas, for improvements to a water system. The funding for the project was awarded by the Farmers Home Administration, a division of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

"Rural water service is the lifeline for many small Kansas communities. I will continue to work with Farmers Home to ensure that this project and other essential rural water Kansas projects receive their fair share of federal funding, " said Dole.

Clayton will receive a grant of \$147,000 and a loan of \$67,800 to assist in upgrading the city's water system including drilling a well, constructing a storage standpipe and replacing the distribution lines. The system serves 50 customers.
