

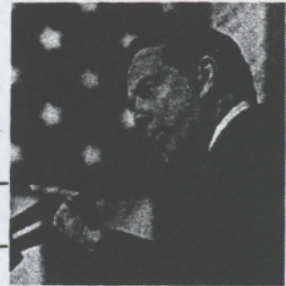

**DOLE ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT OF DON WILSON TO RURAL HEALTH CARE
ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

WASHINGTON -- Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole (R-Kansas) today announced that Don Wilson of Topeka has been appointed by Secretary of Health & Human Services Louis Sullivan to the National Advisory Committee on Rural Health of the Health Resources and Services Administration. Wilson will begin serving a four-year term on July 1, 1992.

"With health care ranking right at the top of concerns for Kansans, it's good to know that someone as experienced and dedicated as Don Wilson will be serving on this important committee. Don will be a plus for Kansas as the board looks into the challenges of upgrading rural health care needs," Dole said.

The National Advisory Committee on Rural Health will advise the Secretary concerning the provision and financing of health care services in rural areas. The Committee will consist of 18 members and will focus attention and existing resources on rural health care delivery problems.

Wilson is currently President of the Kansas Hospital Association, a post he has held since 1982.
