

DOLE ANNOUNCES \$283,000 IN HOUSING GRANTS FOR KANSAS COMMUNITIES

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today two Housing Preservation Grants to organizations that assist low income families with home repairs. The grants were awarded by the Farmers Home Administration.

"It's important to provide needy families with the assistance they need to keep their homes in good, livable condition. These organizations will help many families living in rural areas throughout Kansas," said Dole.

Mennonite Housing Rehabilitation Services Inc. of Wichita will receive \$141,500 to provide funds for families with low and very-low incomes to improve their homes. The funds will be used to assist 50 families in repairing or rehabilitating their homes. The Mennonite Services serves Butler, Harvey, Sedgwick, Sumner, Marion, Reno and Cowley counties.

The North Central-Flint Hills Area Agency on Aging of Manhattan will also receive \$141,500 to provide funds for families with low and very-low incomes to improve their homes. The funds will be used to assist 50 families. The North Central-Flint Hills Agency serves Clay, Cloud, Dickinson, Ellsworth, Geary, Jewell, Lincoln, Marion, Mitchell, Morris, Ottawa, Riley, Republic and Saline counties.
