DOLE ANNOUNCES PUBLIC HOUSING GRANT FOR GAYLORD

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today the Housing Authority of Gaylord, Kansas, will receive a \$60,000 federal grant for improvements to low-income public housing facilities in Gaylord. The grant was awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

"Maintaining good living conditions at public housing facilities in Kansas is fundamental," said Dole, "and this funding will help keep Gaylord's housing units in good shape. It is important that HUD provide assistance where it's needed, and that often means small and medium communities, not just the big East and West Coast urban centers."

The grant was awarded under the Housing Department's Comprehensive Improvement Assistance Program (CIAP). CIAP was established to finance the necessary repair and improvement of low-income public housing facilities constructed under authorization of the U.S. Housing Act.
