UNEMPLOYMENT FIGURES

Washington -- Citing today's news on the unemployment front as the latest indication the White House isn't doing enough to encourage job creation, Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole made the following statement:

If President Clinton wants to do something dramatic about unemployment, he should make a major policy speech announcing that he's junking his massive tax and spend agenda -- now that would be a real stimulus. Otherwise, businesses will continue to put job creation on hold because of the chilling effects of the President's fixation on taxes and spending.

The Commerce Department announced today that unemployment remained at 7% for the third month in a row.
