DOLE RECOMMENDS NEBRASKAN FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE
AMERICAN FOLKLIFE CENTER BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole today announced his recommendation of Charles E. Trimble of Omaha, Nebraska for appointment to the American Folklife Center Board of Trustees.

Trimble, a Lakota Indian, is President of Red Willow Institute, a non-profit organization dedicated to providing management assistance to Native American non-profit organizations and remote Native American communities. He is President of the Native American Community Center of Omaha, and serves on the Nebraska Indian Commission. He is also President of the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Historical Society.

Under the direction of the Library of Congress, the American Folklife Center Board of Trustees develops and implements programs related to the preservation, support, revitalization and dissemination of American Folklife.

The Board of Trustees is composed of twelve citizen members and four ex-officio members.
