**DOLE RECOMMENDS KANSAN FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE**  
**AMERICAN FOLKLIFE CENTER BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole today announced his recommendation of Dr. James F. Hoy of Emporia, Kansas for appointment to the American Folklife Center Board of Trustees.

Dr. Hoy is Professor of English at Emporia State University. He is a past President of the Kansas Folklore Society and board member of the Kansas State Historical Society.

Under the direction of the Library of Congress, the American Folklife Center Board of Trustees develops and implements programs related to the preservation, support, revitalization and dissemination of American Folklife.

The Board of Trustees is composed of twelve citizen members and four ex-officio members.
