The Department of The Air Force has announced a briefing for 35 of the newly elected members of Congress to begin Friday morning, February 17 and running through Saturday and Sunday.

Congressman Bob Dole, Sixth District, Kansas will participate in all phases of the briefings which will include briefings at Air Force Headquarters in the Pentagon; Air Research and Development Command at Andrews Air Force Base near Washington; Strategic Air Command Headquarters at Omaha, Nebraska; the North American Air Defense Command, and Air Force Academy at Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Dole stated he was particularly interested in that phase of the briefings concerning operations of the Strategic Air Command since Schilling Air Force Base at Salina is an important and vital part of it. He added "I am anxious to learn everything possible about SAC operations and to remind my freshmen colleagues of the continuing importance of Schilling in our overall defense setup."

The trip to Omaha and Colorado Springs will be made in a Special Mission Boeing 707 type jet aircraft. The Congressmen will return to Washington Sunday evening
