FROM THE OFFICE OF CONGRESSMAN BOB DOLE, MEMBER OF CONGRESS, SIXTH DISTRICT, KANSAS, WASHINGTON, D. C.

Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans) has been advised by the Department of The Air Force it plans to continue its work during 1961 with the U. S. Weather Bureau to obtain meteorological data on which to base warnings of severe weather.

As in the past, the Air Force will send small teams to locations in the south and central states. An 8-man team will be assigned to duty at Goodland for the period May 21 through September 30. The assignment calls for observance of upper-air phenomena.

"This work will be beneficial not only to military operations, but to the civilian population in areas affected by severe weather", Dole said.
