Congressmen Bob Dole (R-Manses), speaking at Post Office Dedications in European and Tescott yesterday pointed out the repid progress made in postal operations and compared the initial postal system of only 75 Post Offices and 2,000 miles of post roads to todays 12,000 Post Offices which handle more than 63 billion pieces of mail annually.
