PRESS RELEASE FROM THE CEVICE OF CONSPESSMAN BOB DOLE (R-KANSAS) FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: MAY 2, 1962

Cong. Bob Bole (R-Kansas) renewed his demand for an investigation of the Billie Sol Estes matter in the House Committee on Agriculture this morning. Dole indicated that while swaiting final action on the Administration farm bill, the Administration sugar program and other legislation, that the Departmental Oversight and Consumer Relations Subcommittee, of which Dole is a member, could commonce investigation into alleged scandals within the Department of Agriculture.

Chairman Harold Cooley (D-North Caroline) indicated there were already many investigations being conducted and that a further investigation by the Subcounittee on Departmental Oversight and Consumer Relations would be of no value.

Dole stated he would montimue his efforts as available information clearly indicates the need for quick and complete Congressional investigation before any "white-wash" is completed.
