DOLE EXPECTS UEHLING TO BE NAMED TO KANSAS ASCS COMMITTEE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that he expects Ray Uehling, Ness City wheat farmer, to be named to the Kansas State Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service Committee in the very near future.

Uehling served as President of the Kansas Association of Wheat Growers from 1967 to 1969 and as a Director of the National Association of Wheat Growers from 1965 to 1969. He has also served on the Agriculture Secretary's Grain Advisory Committee for the past several years.

Dole said that only final clearance is necessary before the appointment becomes official.
