130 NEW JOBS FOR PRAIRIE VILLAGE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced today that the United States Department of Agriculture will consolidate offices in Prairie Village and Minneapolis, Minnesota into a single location in Prairie Village. This will mean an increase in the Prairie Village office of approximately 130 jobs, with a payroll increase amounting to nearly \$2 million.

"Results of a cost-efficiency study were a major factor in the decision to consolidate," Senator Dole said, "and the location of an electronic data processing center in the area made Prairie Village an ideal place for the enlarged office."

The office will be located in the Brymar Office Center, 2400 West 75th, Prairie Village.
