FIVE HEW GRANTS TO TOPEKA AGENCIES TOTAL \$461,999

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced five grants from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to Topeka agencies and foundations.

The Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services was awarded two grants, totalling \$66,860. \$48,860 will be used to purchase a services management system and \$18,000 will be used in the Nursing Home Ombudsman Program.

The Menninger Foundation received \$61,939 for a research program titled, Psychosomatic Self-Regulation of Migraine Headaches.

The State Department of Education, Division of Vocational Education, will use a \$150,000 grant to study the most effective methods and techniques in career education and to develop exemplary education models.

~~\$183,200~~ A \$183,200 grant was awarded to the Topeka Follow Through Program. Follow Through provides special programs of instruction as well as health, nutrition and other education-related services.
