DOLE JOINS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO FORD CAMPAIGN

(R.-Kans.)

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole has been named to the twelve member panel of advisors to the President Ford Committee.

The Advisory Committee, established to counsel the President and his campaign Chairman, Howard "Bo" Callaway, on campaign policy, met for the first time **Tuesday** afternoon, following President Ford's formal announcement of candidacy.

Dole said the meeting centered primarily on tentative organizational discussion and general preliminary campaign plans.

The former Republican National Chairman indicated that the Advisory Committee met informally with the President and First Lady early Tuesday evening and that their enthusiasm for the coming campaign was apparent. "It's obvious that President Ford believes strongly in the policies he is developing for America, and in the eleven months since he took office, it appears that **he**, and those policies, have been gathering increasing support among the American people," Dole said.
