KANSAS COLLEGES RECEIVE NEARLY \$1.2 MILLION FOR WORK-STUDY PROGRAMS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a total of \$1,181,074 in Health, Education and Welfare grants to 57 Kansas colleges and universities. The funds will be used to provide employment opportunities for an estimated 2,457 students in college work-study programs. Federal funds will provide 80 percent of student payrolls, and a matching college, university or off campus agency contribution will provide the remaining 20 percent.
