WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole tonight called for a reassessment of security procedures employed while President Ford is traveling. Dole said he was grateful the President was unburt but said the events in San Francisco Monday, coming so soon after the September 4 incident, compel a thorough re-examination of procedures to guard against possible threats to the President.

"It's unacceptable to have a situation in which the President's only two choices are shutting himself up in the White House or risking his life every time he wishes to leave it," Dole said. "Congress should look into this matter as quickly as possible to find and recommend every procedural improvement within the law and Constitution."
