DOLE: REPORT RAISES NEW QUESTIONS, ANSWERS NONE

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- "The report raises many new questions, while answering few," Senator Bob Dole said today of the Comptroller's report on the financial dealings of Office of Management and Budget Director Bert Lance.

"Since the Comptroller indicated he intends to consider changes in banking regulations due to the investigation," Dole said in a statement issued through his Washington office, "it is hard to conclude that Mr. Lance acted properly in all situations."

"Today's performance was reminiscent of 'stonewalling tactics' of another era and underscores more than ever the need for the appropriate Congressional committees to fully investigate all the allegations."
