SENATOR DOLE JOINS CONGRESSIONAL HISPANIC CAUCUS

Senator Dole (R-Kansas) recently became an honorary member of the newly formed Congressional Hispanic Caucus.

The Congressional Hispanic Caucus was formed last December in an effort to develop a comprehensive national response to Hispanics, and to provide Members of Congress with legislative and research materials relating to this second largest minority population.

The Congressional Hispanic Caucus has strongly urged all Members of Congress who have Hispanic Americans among their constituencies to join the Caucus as an honorary member.

The Congressional Hispanic Caucus is chaired by the Honorable Edward W. Roybal. Congressional founding members are Congressman Blatasar Corrada, E. "Kika" de la Garza, Herman Badillo, and Henry B. Gonzalez.
